

• Single article: subject of the agreement

Consortium Agreement

- Purpose
 - → Mandatory, complements the Grant Agreement Article 41.3 of the H2020 Model Grant Agreement
 - Agreed between partners (EC not a party)
 - → In order to define more precisely management aspects of the project
 - → Decision-making
 - → IPR (intellectual property rights) management
 - → Funding transfer mechanisms
 - → Etc.
- Procedure
 - Drafted, circulated to all partners for comments by legal departments and signed (within 6 months)
 - → A copy to be sent to EC Coordinator for information

Guarantee Fund = Amount of 5% of EC contribution

No financial collective responsibility Instead: establishment of a participant's Guarantee Fund to cover risks. However, there is "technical responsibility" to carry out the project jointly and severally vis-à-vis the Commission.

Controls and audits

Financial viability

⇒ Most beneficiaries exempt from detailed analysis; only systematic check for coordinators when requested EU funding for the action is ≥ EUR 500 000

Certificates

- ⇒ Certificate on the financial statements (CFS): Only for final payments when total EU contribution claimed by the beneficiary on the basis of actual costs + unit costs for average personnel ≥ EUR 325.000
- ⇒ Certificate on the methodology (COM): Optional for average personnel costs (now under unit costs)

Ex-post audits

⇒ Audits of the Commission limited to two years after the payment of the balance

Sanctions

- **Recovery** procedures (chapter 6 of the Grant Agreement)
- Liquidated damages
- Financial penalties
 - if CFS/COM false declarations and/or repetitive errors
 - Between 2% and 10% of the EC contribution





Coordinator's Project management

- Project & consortium management
 - → Quality management: Project Quality Plan, knowledge management
 - Monitoring of planning, deliverables and milestones, achievement of objectives
 - → Project Risk Management when required
 - → Meetings secretariat (agenda, minutes, GB, ExCom, WPs etc..)
- Legal, administrative, financial management
 - Management of Grant and Consortium Agreements
 - → Coordination of periodic reporting to the EC
 - Financial and budget monitoring
 - → Advice on contractual, administrative, financial matters
- Project communication
 - → Drafting and monitoring of public Communication Action Plan
 - Creation of graphical chart & public communication toolkit: public and private website, printed material (project presentation, brochures, journal...), films, exhibitions stands, etc.
 - → Creation & maintenance of secure web platform for consortium communication
 - Monitoring of relevant international events and participation in selected events

Open Access

Applicable to peer reviewed scientific publications

Open Access = providing online access at no charge to the user to peer-reviewed scientific publications

Open access to publications is an <u>obligation</u> in H2020

- Self-archiving: deposit of manuscripts & immediate/delayed OA provided by author ("Green OA"), often after embargo period set by the (non-OA) publisher
- OA publishing: costs covered & immediate OA provided by publisher ("Gold OA") costs are eligible











Reporting 1/3 Research Participant Portal




Reporting 2/3 Access reporting functions










EU Decision Making Process (timeline)




- Safe and harmonised management of radioactive waste











EU Nuclear Electricity Generation (PINC 2017) and 2050 strategy


2050 Long-term strategy


